

IMPORTANT

When filing the attached Vehicle Appeal, due to the new TAVT (****TAVT is the acronym for Title Ad Valorem Tax****), you **MUST** also attach a copy of the following:

1. The Buyer's Order or Bill of Sale (if your appeal is based on TAVT), which must show the description of the car, VIN#, full purchase price, date, and the mileage.
2. A copy of your "Georgia MVD - Receipt", which had the tag decal attached and shows the Tag #, VIN #, Valuation, etc.

When filling out the Appeal form, you **MUST ANSWER ALL** questions completely. We **MUST HAVE the full description of the car – Year, Make, exact Model, such as if it's an SE, LE, LS, etc., Body Type, ALL options, and mileage, even if it is exempt, etc.**

On the appeal form, **only choose one** of the following, which explains why you are appealing .

**** If you recently purchased a vehicle or you recently moved to Georgia and you wish to file an appeal because you disagree with the vehicle value used for calculating the "TAVT", it MUST be filed within forty-five (45) days of the date the "TAVT" is paid.**

OR

**** If you are filing an appeal because you disagree with the vehicle value used for calculating the "Regular Ad Valorem Tax", it MUST be filed on or before the registration expiration date (your birthdate).**
